

White Twister

Imagine a roller coaster for your bike—that's White Twister. A long series of swoops and turns complete with a half mile climb set you up for the plunge to Stonewall Creek. Just be sure not to get inverted. You finish up on an abandoned rail bed alongside tumbling Stonewall Creek with its numerous small falls.



Mileposts

- From start—ride back up the road you came in on.
- Mile 0.1—turn right on White Twister Trail (white balze).
- Mile 2—turn right. A left takes you to the pay station. This is the top of the hill before the plunge.
- Mile 2.7—confluence of Dump Creek and Stonewall Creek. Cross Dump Creek on small wooden bridge.
- Mile 4—turn right on FS 20.
- Mile 4.3—finish.

START/FINISH

From Tiger go 2.4 miles south on Old US 441 and turn right on FS 20.

There's a pay station just down the road and a larger bike parking lot 1.3 miles further in.
